

# Teaching Assistant Apprenticeship Standard Level 3

The apprenticeship will typically take 18 months to complete, with 20% off-the-job training, although the exact duration will be dependent on the previous knowledge, skills and experience of the individual.

The standard covers the following *knowledge, skills and behaviours*:

## Knowledge

- ◆ Understanding how pupils learn and develop Technology
- ◆ Working with teachers to understand and support assessment for learning
- ◆ Curriculum
- ◆ Keeping Children Safe in Education

## Skills

- ◆ Developing strategies for support
- ◆ Communication and team work
- ◆ Working with teachers to accurately assess
- ◆ Using technology
- ◆ Problem solving/ability to motivate pupils

## Behaviours

- ◆ Building relationships/ embracing change
- ◆ Adding value to education
- ◆ Promoting equality, diversity and inclusion
- ◆ Professional standards and personal accountability
- ◆ Team working, collaboration/ engagement

The End Point Assessment consists of two distinct assessment methods:

- ◆ Practical observation with questions & answers
- ◆ Professional discussion supported by a portfolio of evidence



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
